First Baptist Church Preschool Operating Schedule and Fees School Year 2020-21

First Baptist Church Preschool will operate from 7:30 AM - 11:30 AM, Monday through Friday. An Early Bird arrival option is available for \$2 per day giving the option of checking in between 7 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. An extended care session will be offered from 11:30 AM - 5:30 PM for those parents who choose to use it. There will be classes offered for two, three, and four-year-old children.

Tuition is based on a yearly rate, which may be broken down into nine installment payments as listed below in bold print. Tuition may be paid once (with discount) at the beginning of the year, in two payments per year or monthly from August through April. The first installment is due August 1. This installment should be mailed to FBC Preschool, P. O. Box 99, Senatobia, MS 38668. September through April installments should be given to your child's teacher or the preschool director each month.

Extended Care:

This is an optional program. You may choose to let your child stay one, two, three, four or five days per week. You may set this up for a definite schedule, or just leave your child when you find it necessary for your schedule. Cost for Extended Care is as follows:

11:30 am - 12:30 pm - \$3.50 per day (includes lunch)
Past 12:30 pm until 5:30 pm - \$12.00 per day (includes lunch)
Past 5:30 p.m. - \$1.00 per minute late fee
A copy of the lunch menu will be provided.

Registration fee: \$200 (non-refundable)

This fee is due by <u>May 1</u>. This fee covers insurance costs, paper products, supplies, curriculum, toys, license fees, t-shirt and many other operational costs. **Your child's enrollment is not guaranteed until application form is completed and the registration fee is paid.**

Shot Record: Form 121

This form must be submitted by <u>May 1.</u> The MS State Department of Health requires that all children must submit FORM 121. You can get this from your doctor or the local health department.
