As we planned to partner with this ministry, the WMU of the Sisterhood realized that we also had the ability to pack "snack" bags. They gathered toiletries, socks, washcloths and more and packed 30 bags to be delivered with the mats and pillows!! As news of the delivery of the items spread, another Sister suggested we get blankets donated. Before we knew it, we had a load of blankets to take as well! The original project blossomed into such a BIG, beautiful product from so many Sisters. It truly was a picture of us all being a part of the body of Christ doing our part in Kingdom work!







A couple of brothers built us a loom, and that gave us double work space. We have hosted a couple of Saturday "workdays", and many ladies have come out. Our younger and older Sisters seem to really love helping in the folding, cutting, and tying part of the project. Several ladies took "plarn" with them to crochet mats at home, and a team of ladies have spent countless hours at the church throughout the weeks looming the mats.



One Sister had the idea that we should make little travel pillows using waterproof material for the outside and the bag scraps as the pillow's stuffing. NOTHING from that "beautiful bag" is wasted! It was a GAME CHANGER!! They turned out amazing!









Tuesday, February 28th, a team of ladies (and Bro. Chris- our fearless driver) loaded up the mats, pillows, blankets and "snack" bags, and headed to Memphis. They met the other ministry team, loaded the food items, and headed downtown.
