A Study of Genesis

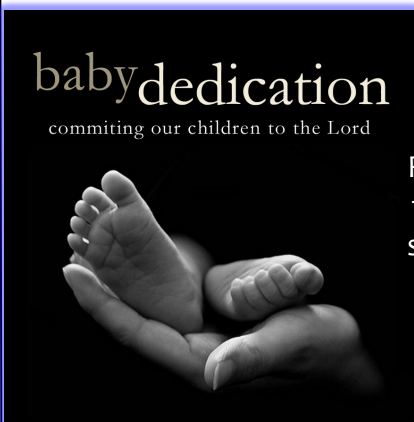
June 4th-"Family Lines" (Genesis 5)
