#### FROM THE PULPIT



This Sunday, June 18th, we will be taking a break from our study of the book of Genesis. Instead, the sermon will focus on Fatherhood in the Bible. We will consider a few different fathers in the Bible —some good, some not so good. The sermon will culminate with a description of the good and perfect Father, the Lord of God. If you are a father, a stepfather of even a surrogate to someone, I hope you will be encouraged and edified by what we read in God's Word this Sunday morning. Even if you aren't part of our regular choir, I hope you will consider coming to sing in this night that is designed to bring our community of faith in Senatobia together.

John 15:10-14; "If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full. This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends if you do what I command you."

There is a perfect equation in this passage: keep my commands = abide in God's love = our joy will be full. Joy is a byproduct of God in our walk each day but it only comes as we keep his commandments. Not just the easy ones "don't steal," I don't have much problem with that. But what about gossip, slander, mean spirited, fear, apathy, gluttony, worry, flattery, consumerism, lying, envy, pride ... the list can go on and on and on. Did that step on your toes? It did mine! So, what is the answer ... be in God's Word, be in church, be accountable to other believers and be intentional is seeking after God! See you Sunday, Randy
