When reading the 10 Psalms which include Psalm 119, I must set aside some extra time, because Psalm 119 is lengthy. There are a total of 176 verses in this Psalm. Remember that each Psalm is the equivalent to a hymn. This song would have taken forever to sing in its entirety! This Sunday each of our supporting verses will be taken from this Psalm.
